up-market card – a card which is issued (often as a gold card) to persons of a higher income bracket and which is provided with a high spending limit and additional features

valid card – a card that has passed the valid date and has not yet expired
gültige Karte

valid date – the date embossed on the card before which the card must not be honoured
Gültigkeitsbeginn

validation – a process to verify the validity of a card
 vcf.: validity check
Gültigkeitsüberprüfung

validity – the period during which the card can be honoured
Gültigkeit

validity check – a process to verify the validity of a card
 cf.: validation
Gültigkeitsüberprüfung

value chain – the entirety of the different stages of the transactions flow from the acquirer via the acquirer processor, the switch(es), the issuer processor to the issuer and the value created in this chain
Wertschöpfungskette

value checker – a device to show the balance of an electronic purse and the last transactions see also: balance reader
Wertanzeiger

value date – the day on which the value of an amount commences to bear interest
Tag, an dem die Zinsberechnung für den betreffenden Wert beginnt oder endet

value-added benefit – additional benefit linked to a card to enhance its value
 cf.: value-added service
Zusatzleistung

value-added service – additional service linked to a card to enhance its value
 cf.: value-added benefit
Zusatzleistung

vending machines application – an off-line POS solution catering to the special needs of this type of sales business with generally low maximum transaction amounts
 see also: quick payment service (QPS), QPS (quick payment service), rapid payment service (RPS), RPS (rapid payment service) offline POS-Lösung für Verkaufsautomaten

Verified by Visa – a standard for secure payments with Visa cards in the Internet/in the virtual world
 see also: MasterCard SecureCode
sichere Zahlungsform mit Visa-Karten im Internet/in der virtuellen Welt, Verified by Visa

vicinity payment – a contactless payment with a chip (card) whereby there is a distance up to 1 metre between card and reader
 see also: contactless purse, proximity payment
berührungslose Zahlung

virtual card – a “card” which only exists as a number
 opp.: physical card
nur als Nummer existierende „Karte“

virtual commerce – the purchase of goods/services on an electronic market place


cf.: e-business, e-commerce, electronic commerce
 see also: electronic marketplace, virtual marketplace
elektronische Geschäfte, virtuelle Geschäfte, elektronischer Kauf von Waren/Dienstleistungen

virtual market place – the electronic market where goods/services are offered electronically
 cf.: electronic marketplace
 opp.: physical marketplace
 see also: e-business, e-commerce, electronic commerce, virtual commerce
elektronischer Markt, virtueller Markt

Visa – a licensed card system with the licences being granted by Visa International
 see also: Visa Electron card, Visa card, Visa International
